

# Cash ISA Summary Box



This summary box sets out important information that applies to our Cash ISA account. You should carefully read this document along with the Cash ISA Terms and Conditions to allow you make an informed decision as to whether this product is right for you.

### What is the interest rate?

Interest is calculated and accrued daily based on the balance in your account. Interest will be paid into your account annually at the beginning of April.

### Can AIB(NI) change the interest rate?

- The interest rate is variable which means we can change the rate from time to time as set out in the interest section of the Cash ISA Terms & Conditions.
- If we decide to reduce the rates, we will provide with at least 14 days' notice by sending you a letter.
- If we decide to increase the rates, we will notify you as soon as possible.

### What would the estimated balance be after 12 months based on £1,000, £15,000 and £35,000 deposits?

### How do I open and manage my account?

- You can open an account at any of our branches.
- It is available to personal customers only who are resident in the UK for tax purposes and either:
  - aged 18 years or over on the date the Account is opened
  - aged 16 or 17 before 6 April 2024.
- A minimum lodgement of £50 is required to open an account.
- Subscriptions to the AIB Cash ISA are determined by the Government and can change from time to time. You can save up to £20,000 in your 2025/2026 tax allowance.
- You can credit or debit your Cash ISA account through online or mobile banking or by visiting any AIB branch. Annual Subscription limits apply.

### Can I withdraw money?

Yes. The Cash ISA provides instant access to your funds when you need them. Funds can be withdrawn via:

- in any of our branches,
- by transfer (online<sup>1</sup>)

**However, if you withdraw funds, you may not be able to replace the funds if you have reached your annual subscription limit.** If you withdraw from your Cash ISA, you may drop to a lower interest tier.

### Additional information

#### Tax

We do not deduct tax from the interest we pay you in accordance with current legislation. Investors should be aware that the favourable tax treatment of ISAs may change or not be maintained in the future.
